If you will be driving to and from more than one location.
- Photograph/Media Consent and Release Form**
- Volunteer Insurance Program**
Volunteer Assignment Acknowledge Form & Volunteer Insurance Brochure.
- LiveScan (background check) by appointment only**
Once application is received further instructions to get a Live Scan background check will be sent to you. Please note that background checks can take 2-4 weeks to process.

*Once the items above have been cleared through Volunteer Services your next step(s) will be to complete any trainings, exam and courses depending on which program you are volunteering for.
